

# Additional Supplementary Regulations



These ASR's will apply to all AROC Ltd RTVs, CCVTs and Safaris unless otherwise stated in Roveround.

Every event will be covered by an MSA permit. Every event will be held under the general competition regulations of the Motor Sport Association Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the international sporting code of the FIA), AROC Ltd general rules and these ASR's.

The events are open to all fully elected members of the AROC Ltd and all fully elected members of any pre-invited club covered by the event permit.

All competitors and passengers must show a current membership card before they will be allowed to sign on. Ages: Safari - driver 17/passenger 16; Trials - driver 17/passenger 14.

Signing on and Scrutineering will be from 08.30 to 09.30 on the day of the event. Anyone not signed on by 09.30 may be penalised; anyone not signed on by 09.45 may be excluded from entering. For competitive safaris the clubs safari representative will allocate race numbers on request.

The maximum number of starters for any event is 50, the minimum number of starters for timed events only is 10. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes as necessary if the number of entries in any particular class is less than 3.

A second fixed seat for passenger is not required if no passenger is carried. A spare wheel and tyre need not be carried.

Minimum tyre pressures are: RTV 20psi; CCVT 12psi; Safaris 16psi

RTV entrants must display a current Road Fund Licence to be eligible for awards.

Vehicles must be equipped with towing points front and rear.

Seat belts must be worn during all events (RTV, minimum lap belt - lap and diagonal recommended; CCVT, minimum lap belt, two shoulder straps strongly recommended; Safari, two shoulder and lap straps minimum, full harness with crutch strap recommended).

All silencing must conform to a maximum permitted noise level of 84dBA measured at 8m and can be checked during scrutineering or at random.

Entry fees for trials are £20.00 on the day ~~and £15.00 if pre-booked. Entries must be sent to Dave Wise to arrive at least 2 days before the event.~~

Entry fees for Safaris are £45.00 and are pre-booked ONLY 10 entries must be received by the date published in Roveround for the event to be viable to run.

If it is necessary to change venue, date or cancel and event only pre booked entries will be contacted.

All competitors are advised to check the website for updates.

Results of the event will be posted 10 minutes before prize giving. Any queries or objections must be brought to the attention of the meeting secretary immediately. No objections will be considered after the results are read out during prize giving. A copy of the results will be published in the club magazine at the first convenient date.

Looping or crossing tracks will not be allowed on any part of a section at any time, unless specifically instructed to do so by the Clerk of the Course.

Speeding on site will not be tolerated and must be limited to 5mph off sections.

No smoking anywhere on a trials course.

Officials Rota - every time a member competes at an AROC event they are awarded 1 point. When their number of points reaches 10 they are required to marshal at an event to reduced the points to 0. New members will automatically be awarded 7 points. Secretary of Meetings and Scrutineers will also have their points reduced to zero but will not be counted as marshalling at these events for any annual awards that require marshalling.
